



MINI 14/30 Stock Bedding

Your rifle has been bedded with the finest materials and will last many years with little care. To achieve a tight fit, each rifle is individually fitted, and bedding applied so that good contact is made and the receiver is well supported. This fit will make it a little more difficult to remove from the stock, but it was designed to be removed for maintenance. We recommend a hardwood dowel and rubber mallet to help separate the action from the stock. After removal of the trigger group turn the rifle upside down and place the dowel against the underside of the receiver. Tap with the mallet until the receiver comes out of the stock.

Don't be afraid to take it apart and perform cleaning chores after a day at the range or season's end. The materials used are very durable and will withstand regular handling. Don't force the stock and action back together with excessive force, use firm and constant pressure and they will fit back together. A gentle slap to the top of the receiver may be necessary on some stocks, especially laminated wood models.

Small chips, cracks or voids are not detrimental to the bedding and the performance of the rifle. Large ones can be. That's really subjective, so as long as the bedding remains intact and the rifle performs well don't worry about it. Damage by excessive force or abuse is self evident, and failures of the product due to defects in material or application are covered on an individual basis.

On synthetic stocks (especially, but wood as well) it is possible for the bedding to separate from the stock under certain conditions. If this ever happens please contact us for repair of the problem. It is unlikely to ever happen, but I need to make you aware that it can.

It's a good idea to test a few different loads and see if your rifle still prefers its previous favorite. The difference in fit to the stock will affect the overall performance of the rifle, in a positive manner, and you may find the rifle now prefers a different load for accuracy work.
